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Deep Engagement:
 Student takes full ownership of learning activities, displaying high levels of energy, a willingness to ask questions, pursues answers, considers alternatives, and takes risks

Engagement:
 Student begins taking ownership of learning activities. Involvement shows concentration and effort to understand and complete the task. Not simply following directions but actively working to improve performance.

Active Participation:
 Student participates in learning activities and stays on task without teacher intervention. However, work has a routine or rote quality without commitment.

Passive Participation:
 Student follows directions in a routine manner. With teacher guidance and direction, student remains on task.

Periodic Participation:
 Student's attention and participation fluctuates. Can be easily distracted, requiring significant teacher attention and direction.
